Cellular One Launches New Cell Site in Dixon Montana

Missoula, MT – April 8, 2009—Cellular One continues to expand its coverage of the Missoula area with the launch of another new cell site. This new site is located in Dixon, within the Flathead Indian Reservation along Highway 200, just West of Ravalli. This funding helps pay for rural network construction and operation, so residents can have reliable wireless coverage like the rest of the country.
